Residency Requirement: a minimum of **30** course credits and at least half (50 per cent) of the course credits required in each undergraduate degree program major/minor must be taken at York University.

Major Credits: As defined by the specific programs; a minimum of 42 credits in each of the majors, at least **12** credits of which must be at the 4000 level in each major programs. A course may count for major credit towards only one of the major.

Upper-Level Requirements: Of the required 120 credits for the degree, students must complete at least **36** credits at the 3000 level, or 4000 level, including at least **18** credits at the 4000 level.
